Financial Advisory Council

Purpose: To serve in an advisory capacity to the Board of Education and administration in providing financial advice and support in evaluation of the district's financial performance, development of future projections, and review of the overall fiscal condition of the district.

Objective: To maximize the academic achievement and growth of all students by expanding our focus on efficiency, effectiveness, and innovation.

The Primary Roles of the Advisory Council:

Stewardship: To review internal and external fiscal issues and trends facing the school district and provide input, and support into the district's overall condition, operations, and programming.

Community Perspective: To serve as a community liaison and an impartial observer of the district's finances to maximize utilization of resources in our community.

Communication: To serve as ambassadors for students, the Board and Administration in developing avenues for communication and greater transparency.

Membership: The members of the Financial Advisory Council shall be appointed by the Board of Education. The committee will be comprised of five community members, two board members, superintendent, treasurer, and one staff member to represent the many stakeholders of the Jonathan Alder school community.

Meetings: Meetings will be scheduled quarterly, unless otherwise determined by the members of the committee. Agenda items will be established in collaboration with the Finance Advisory Council, treasurer and superintendent. Minutes of the meetings will be created and posted on the district's website.
