



Verification Form

The owner or operator of a noncommunity public water system (PWS) with a Tier 3 violation or situation is required to notify the people served by the PWS as soon as practical but **no later than 30 days** after the system learns of the violation. Complete and submit this form to the Ohio EPA District Office after completing the public notice.

Deadlines

Deadline to complete the public notice: 03/01/2023

Deadline to submit this form and a copy of the completed public notice: 03/11/2023

Use one or more of the following methods to issue the public notice:

Post notice in easily seen locations throughout the distribution system

Must remain posted for at least 7 days or for as long as the violation exists, whichever is longer.

1st date of posting: 2/8/23

Last date of posting: 2/15/23

(Must be at least 7 days after 1st date of posting)

Location(s) of posting: Website Above Drinking Fountain
(e.g., bulletin board, restroom door, front door)

Mail* or other direct delivery* to each customer and service connection (where known)


